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


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
SEPTEMBER 2019

In September 2019, **Spain's exports advanced by 5.8%** year-on-year in nominal terms to 23,468.8 million euros, and **imports went up by 8.9%** to 27,731.3 million euros. With seasonally adjusted data, exports grew by 3.1% year-on-year, and imports increased by 5.7%. In **real terms**, exports expanded by 6.8% year-on-year, as export prices declined by 0.9%, and imports augmented by 12.5%, as import prices diminished by 3.2%. In nominal terms on a **month-on-month** basis, exports grew by 20.7%, and imports by 18.4%. With seasonally adjusted data, exports expanded by 0.9% month-on-month, and imports by 2.0%.






Spain's **trade balance** registered a deficit of 4,262.5 million euros, up from a deficit of 3,297.1 million euros in September 2018 (provisional data). The export/import **coverage ratio** reached 84.6%, 2.4 percentage points lower than in the same month of 2018 (87.1% in September 2018 with provisional data). The **non-energy trade balance** reached a deficit of 2,562.5 million euros, up from a deficit of 1,729.9 million in the same month of 2018. The **energy trade deficit** rose by 8.5% year-on-year to 1,700.1 million euros (compared to a deficit of 1,567.2 million euros in September 2018).



Sectoral data


Spain's **main exporting sectors** in September 2019 were *capital goods* (representing 19.1% of total exports and decreasing by 0.2% year-on-year), *vehicles* (16.5% of total, increasing by 17.1%), *food, beverages and tobacco* (15.1% of total, rising by 10.8%) and *chemical products* (14.7% of total, advancing by 7.4%).



The **most significant sectors of Spain's imports** were *capital goods* (representing 21.9% of total imports and expanding by 14.1% year-on-year), *chemical products* (15.5% of total, growing by 2.6%), *consumption goods* (13.2% of total, rising by 12.3%) and *energy* (13.1% of total, advancing by 1.2%).

Among **subsectors**, **the largest contributions** to the annual change in Spain's **exports** in September 2019 (up by 5.8%) came from *cars and motorcycles* (2.8 points), *medicines* (0.9 points) and *meat products* (0.8 points). The major negative contributions corresponded to *aircraft* (-0.9 points), *oil and by-products* (-0.4 points) and *non-ferrous metals* (-0.4 points).


Exports (top/bottom contrib. to annual change, p.p.) Imports (top/bottom contrib. to annual change, p.p.)



The **subsectors with the most positive contribution** to the annual change in Spain's **imports** in September 2019 (up by 8.9%) were *cars and motorcycles* (1.0 points), *automotive parts and accessories* (0.8 points) and *ships* (0.8 points). The major negative contributions corresponded to *coal and electricity* (-0.5 points), *engines* (-0.3 points) and *other chemical products* (-0.2 points).


Geographic data

Exports to the **European Union** accounted for 67.1% of total exports in September 2019 (up from 66.8% in September 2018) and increased by 6.2% year-on-year. Exports to the **euro area** ran at 52.2% (down from 52.5% in September 2018) and expanded by 5.2%. Exports to **non-EU countries** represented 32.9% of total exports (down from 33.2% in September 2018) as they grew by 5.0% year-on-year.




Imports from the **European Union** amounted to 54.0% of total imports in September 2019 (down from 54.3% in September 2018) and augmented by 8.2% year-on-year. Imports from the **euro area** represented 42.8% (down from 43.2% in September 2018) and went up by 8.0%. Imports from **non-EU countries** accounted for 46.0% of total imports in September 2019 (up from 45.7% in September 2018) as they advanced by 9.6% year-on-year.






Imports EU and extra-EU (% y-o-y trend-cycle)



Trade balance with the European Union showed in September 2019 a surplus of 763.1 million euros (down from a surplus of 974.4 million in September 2018) and a surplus of 381.1 million euros with the euro area (657.3 million surplus in September 2018). **Trade deficit with the rest of the world** increased to 5,025.6 million euros (from a deficit of 4,271.5 million euros in September 2018).

The **destinations with the largest contributions** to the annual change in Spain's **exports** in September 2019 (up by 5.8%) were the United Kingdom (1.4 percentage points), Italy (1.0 points), the United States (0.7 points) and Belgium (0.6 points). Those destinations with the largest negative contributions were Gibraltar (-0.6 points), Saudi Arabia (-0.3 points), Mexico (-0.2 points) and Algeria (-0.2 points).



Regarding **imports**, the **countries with the largest contributions** to the annual change in Spain's **imports** in September 2019 (up by 8.9%) were France (1.2 percentage points), China (1.1 points), the United States (1.0 points) and Germany (0.9 points). The destinations with the largest negative contributions were Kazakhstan (-0.7 points), Mexico (-0.4 points), Angola (-0.3 points) and Iran (-0.3 points).

International data

In comparison to other geographical areas, Spain's exports of goods advanced by 5.8% year-on-year in September, a higher increase than those of the euro area (3.2%) and the European Union (3.0%). Within the European Union, exports also augmented in Germany (4.6%), France (3.7%) and Italy (6.2%), whereas those of the United Kingdom fell (-3.9%). Outside the European Union, the United States exports decreased by 3.3%, China's by 3.8% and Japan's by 5.2%.


JANUARY - SEPTEMBER 2019

Spain's exports grew by 1.6% in the period of January-September 2019 compared to the same period of 2018 to 215,600.0 million euros, and imports augmented by 2.0% year-on-year to 241,045.7 million euros. In real terms, exports advanced by 0.9% year-on-year, as export prices increased by 0.7%, and imports expanded by 1.9% year-on-year, as import prices rose by 0.1%.

Spain's trade deficit increased to 25,445.7 million euros compared to the same period of 2018 (deficit of 24,187.3 million euros). The export/import **coverage ratio** reached 89.4%, 0.3 percentage points lower than in the same period of 2018 (89.8%, provisional data). The **non-energy trade balance** reached a deficit of 7,910.2 million euros, compared to a deficit of 5,894.0 million euros in January-September 2018, whereas the **energy trade deficit** declined by 4.1% year-on-year to 17,535.5 million euros.


Sectoral data

Spain's **main exporting sectors** in the period of January-September were *capital goods* (representing 20.4% of total exports, rising by 5.3% year-on-year), *food, beverages and tobacco* (16.5% of total, advancing by 4.5%), *vehicles* (15.2% of total, declining by 2.7%) and *chemical products* (14.7% of total, expanding by 3.8%).



The **largest shares by sector of Spain's imports** were those of *capital goods* (representing 21.2% of total and increasing by 5.0% year-on-year), *chemical products* (16.0% of total imports, growing by 6.0%), *energy* (13.9% of total imports, diminishing by 3.3%) and *vehicles* (12.6% of total imports, advancing by 1.1%).


Among **subsectors**, the largest contributions to the annual change in Spain's **exports** (up by 1.6%) were *aircraft* (0.5 percentage points), *medicines* (0.5 points) and *meat products* (0.3 points). On the other hand, the major negative contributions by subsectors corresponded to *electrical machinery* (-0.3 points), *cars* and *motorcycles* (-0.3 points) and *minerals* (-0.2 points).



The **subsectors with the most positive contributions** to the annual change in Spain's **imports** in January-September 2019 (up by 2.0%) were *telecommunication equipment* (0.4 points), *organic chemical products* (0.4 points) and *garment* (0.3 points). The major negative contributions corresponded to *oil and by-products* (-0.4 points), *minerals* (-0.4 points) and *coal and electricity* (-0.3 points).

Geographic data

Exports to the **European Union** represented 65.8% of total exports in the period (equal value as in the same period of 2018) and rose by 1.6% year-on-year, and exports to the **euro area** ran at 51.4% of total (51.6% in the same period of 2018) and grew by 1.1%. Exports to the **rest of the world** amounted to 34.2% of total exports (similar value as in the same period of 2018) and augmented by 1.6% year-on-year.




Imports from the **European Union** accounted for 53.2% of total imports in January-September 2019 (down from 53.9% in the same period of 2018) and went up by 0.7% year-on-year. Imports from the **euro area** amounted to 42.2% (43.5% in the same period of 2018) and shrank by 1.0%. Imports from the **rest of the world** ran at 46.8% of total imports (46.1% in the same period of 2018) and expanded by 3.4% year-on-year.

Spain's trade surplus with the European Union and with the euro area increased to 13,649.6 million euros and to 8,975.2 million euros respectively, from surpluses of 12,306.6 million and 6,752.6 million euros in the same period of the previous year. The **trade deficit with the rest of the world** advanced by 7.1% year-on-year to 39,095.3 million euros.

In terms of **contribution to the annual change of exports** (up by 1.6%), the main contributions were those of Switzerland (0.3 percentage points), Portugal (0.3 points), the United States (0.3 points) and the United Kingdom (0.2 points). Those destinations with the largest negative contributions were Turkey (-0.3 points), Saudi Arabia (-0.2 points), Belgium (-0.2 points) and Iran (-0.1 points).






Regarding **imports**, the **countries with the largest contribution** to the annual change in Spain's **imports** in the period (up by 2.0%) were China (0.9 percentage points), the United States (0.7 points), the Netherlands (0.3 points) and Turkey (0.3 points). The destinations with the largest negative contributions were Iran (-0.8 points), France (-0.4 points), Brazil (-0.4 points) and Algeria (-0.2 points).

In the period January-September, the number of **Spanish exporters over 1.000 euros** attained 82,823, 0.1% less than in the same period of 2018, out of which 35,127 had already exported at least 50,000 euros worth of goods in the period, 1.3% more than in the same period of the previous year with an increase in exports of 1.6%. With regard to regular exporters (those that have already exported in the current year as well as in each of the three preceding years), they amounted to 51,414 in the period, 29.7% of total exporters and 2.3% more than in the same period of 2018. Their exports reached 205,853.9 million, 95.5% of total exports and 1.4% more than in the same period of the previous year.

International data

In comparison to other geographical areas, Spain's exports of goods expanded by 1.6% year-on-year in the period of January-September 2019, a lower rate than those attained by the euro area (2.2%) and the European Union (2.4%). Within the European Union, exports also increased in Germany (0.9%), France (4.1%) and Italy (2.5%), whereas those of the United Kingdom diminished (-0.7%). Outside the European Union, the United States exports decreased by 1.2%, China's by 0.5% and Japan's by 4.8%.

METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

- The statistics presented in this report correspond to international trade in goods statistics of declared trade data provided by the Spanish <u>Customs and Excise Department</u> (Tax Agency) and compiled according to the UN Manual of International Merchandise Trade Statistics (IMTS 2010). It does not include Intra-EU estimates for trade below the exemption threshold.
- Data for the reference year are provisional. Final data are published at the end of the following year. In between, they are not subject to revision. In provisional data, those Intrastat operations being informed after the publication of its corresponding reference month will be assigned to the nearest pending month. Notwithstanding, in the final data all operations will be assigned to their corresponding reference month. Year-on-year percentage change is always calculated with homogenous data (provisional over provisional basis, even if final data are already available for the previous year).
- Information in real terms is provided by the Ministry of Economy and Business and it is calculated using Unit Value Indices.
- Data seasonally adjusted: the estimation of the model, the decomposition of the series and its seasonal and calendar adjustment have been carried out manually using TRAMO-SEATS program. The calendar regressors have been calculated taking into account INE's "Standard for adjusting seasonal and calendar effects in short-term series" (link). The selected models are: ARIMA (0,1,1) x (0,1,1) for exports and ARIMA (0,1,1) x (0,1,1) for imports, with the series in logarithms.
- Sectoral data: the correspondence table between sectors and sub-sectors shown in the report and the 5-digit codes of the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC Rev. 4) is available on:

- Geographic data: imports are classified according to the country of origin of the merchandise.

 commodity or Spanish region.
