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


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
OCTOBER 2019

In October 2019, **Spain's exports went up by 1.7%** year-on-year in nominal terms to 26,861.4 million euros, whereas **imports diminished by 2.7%** to 29,438.0 million euros. With seasonally adjusted data, exports fell by 0.9% year-on-year, and imports dropped by 5.4%. In **real terms**, exports increased by 1.1% year-on-year, as export prices grew by 0.6%, whereas imports decreased by 1.0%, as import prices diminished by 1.7%. In nominal terms on a **month-on-month** basis, exports advanced by 14.5%, and imports expanded by 6.2%. With seasonally adjusted data, exports advanced by 0.5% month-on-month, while imports declined by 4.2%.




Spain's **trade balance** registered a deficit of 2,576.6 million euros, down from a deficit of 3,836.5 million euros in October 2018 (provisional data). The export/import **coverage ratio** reached 91.2%, 3.9 percentage points higher than in the same month of 2018 (87.3% in October 2018 with provisional data). The **non-energy trade balance** reached a deficit of 764.9 million euros down from a deficit of 1,114.0 million in the same month of 2018. The **energy trade deficit** fell by 33.5% year-on-year to 1,811.6 million euros (compared to a deficit of 2,722.5 million euros in October 2018).






Sectoral data

Spain's **main exporting sectors** in October 2019 were *capital goods* (representing 20.0% of total exports and increasing by 1.7% year-on-year), *food, beverages and tobacco* (16.2% of total, rising by 12.0%), *vehicles* (16.0% of total, expanding by 4.3%) and *chemical products* (14.7% of total, advancing by 5.8%).



The most significant sectors of Spain's imports were capital goods (representing 21.4% of total imports and growing by 3.5% year-on-year), chemical products (15.8% of total, advancing by 5.9%), consumption goods (12.9% of total, rising by 6.3%) and energy (12.4% of total, shrinking by 29.7%).

Among subsectors, the largest contributions to the annual change in Spain's exports in October 2019 (up by 1.7%) came from cars and motorcycles (1.4 points), meat products (1.0 points) and medicines (0.6 points). The major negative contributions corresponded to oil and by-products (-2.1 points), automotive parts and accessories (-0.8 points) and iron and steel (-0.4 points).




The subsectors with the most positive contribution to the annual change in Spain's imports in October 2019 (down by 2.7%) were medicines (0.6 points), garment (0.5 points) and automotive parts and accessories (0.4 points). The major negative contributions corresponded to oil and by-products (-3.1 points), gas (-1.5 points) and coal and electricity (-0.4 points).


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<u>Geographic data</u>

Exports to the **European Union** accounted for 66.1% of total exports in October 2019 (up from 65.1% in October 2018) and increased by 3.1% year-on-year. Exports to the **euro area** ran at 51.4% (up from 50.8% in October 2018) and grew by 2.9%. Exports to **non-EU countries** represented 33.9% of total exports (down from 34.9% in October 2018) as they fell by 1.0% year-on-year.




Imports from the **European Union** amounted to 54.2% of total imports in October 2019 (up from 51.9% in October 2018) and went up by 1.8% year-on-year. Imports from the **euro area** represented 42.8% (up from 41.6% in October 2018) and grew by 0.1%. Imports from **non-EU countries** accounted for 45.8% of total imports in October 2019 (down from 48.1% in October 2018) as they declined by 7.5% year-on-year.



Trade balance with the European Union showed in October 2019 a surplus of 1,775.8 million euros (up from a surplus of 1,516.7 million in October 2018) and a surplus of 1,202.7 million euros with the euro area (820.4 million surplus in October 2018). **Trade deficit with the rest of the world** decreased to 4,352.3 million euros (from a deficit of 5,353.2 million euros in October 2018).

The **destinations with the largest contributions** to the annual change in Spain's **exports** in October 2019 (up by 1.7%) were Germany (0.7 percentage points), the United States (0.5 points), Portugal (0.4 points) and Belgium (0.4 points). Those destinations with the largest negative contributions were Algeria (-0.6 points), the Netherlands (-0.5 points), Egypt (-0.2 points) and Singapore (-0.2 points).



Regarding **imports**, the **countries with the largest contributions** to the annual change in Spain's **imports** in October 2019 (down by 2.7%) were the United States (1.2 percentage points), the United Kingdom (0.4 points), the Netherlands (0.4 points) and China (0.3 points). The destinations with the largest negative contributions were Algeria (-1.0 points), Kazakhstan (-0.6 points), Italy (-0.6 points) and Iraq (-0.6 points).

International data

In comparison to other geographical areas, Spain's exports of goods went up by 1.7% year-on-year in October, a higher increase than those of the euro area (1.6%) and the European Union (1.5%). Within the European Union, exports also advanced in Germany (1.9%), France (0.2%), Italy (4.3%) and the United Kingdom (3.2%). Outside the European Union, the United States exports dropped by 3.3%, China's by 2.0% and Japan's by 9.2%.


JANUARY - OCTOBER 2019

Spain's exports grew by 1.6% in the period of January-October 2019 compared to the same period of 2018 to 242,461.4 million euros, and imports rose by 1.5% year-on-year to 270,483.6 million euros. In real terms, exports augmented by 1.0% year-on-year, as export prices increased by 0.7%, and imports rose by 1.5% year-on-year, as import prices declined by 0.1%.

Spain's trade deficit reached 28,022.3 million euros, similar value as in the same period of 2018 (deficit of 28,023.8 million euros). The export/import **coverage ratio** was 89.6%, 0.2 percentage points higher than in the same period of 2018 (89.5%, provisional data). The **non-energy trade balance** reached a deficit of 8,675.1 million euros, compared to a deficit of 7,008.0 million euros in January-October 2018, whereas the **energy trade deficit** declined by 7.9% year-on-year to 19,347.1 million euros.

Sectoral data


Spain's **main exporting sectors** in the period of January-October were *capital goods* (representing 20.3% of total exports, advancing by 4.9% year-on-year), *food, beverages and tobacco* (16.5% of total, growing by 5.3%), *vehicles* (15.3% of total, diminishing by 1.9%) and *chemical products* (14.7% of total, expanding by 4.0%).



The **largest shares by sector of Spain's imports** were those of *capital goods* (representing 21.2% of total and increasing by 4.9% year-on-year), *chemical products* (16.0% of total imports, growing by 6.0%), *energy* (13.7% of total imports, declining by 6.8%) and *vehicles* (12.6% of total imports, rising by 1.0%).

Among **subsectors**, the largest contributions to the annual change in Spain's **exports** (up by 1.6%) were *medicines* (0.5 percentage points), *meat products* (0.4 points) and *aircraft* (0.4 points). On the other hand, the major negative contributions by subsectors corresponded to *oil and by-products* (-0.4 points), *electrical machinery* (-0.3 points) and *minerals* (-0.3 points).

Imports (top/bottom contrib. to annual change, p.p.)




The **subsectors with the most positive contributions** to the annual change in Spain's **imports** in January-October 2019 (up by 1.5%) were *telecommunication equipment* (0.4 points), *garment* (0.4 points) and *organic chemical products* (0.3 points). The major negative contributions corresponded to *oil and by-products* (-0.7 points), *minerals* (-0.4 points) and *coal and electricity* (-0.3 points).

Geographic data

Exports (top/bottom contrib. to annual change, p.p.)

Exports to the **European Union** represented 65.9% of total exports in the period (up from 65.7% in the same period of 2018) and increased by 1.8% year-on-year, and exports to the **euro area** ran at 51.4% of total (51.5% in the same period of 2018) and augmented by 1.3%. Exports to the **rest of the world** amounted to 34.1% of total exports (34.3% in the same period of 2018) and grew by 1.3% year-on-year.




Imports from the **European Union** accounted for 53.3% of total imports in January-October 2019 (down from 53.6% in the same period of 2018) and advanced by 0.9% year-on-year. Imports from the **euro area** amounted to 42.3% (43.3% in the same period of 2018) and fell by 0.9%. Imports from the **rest of the world** ran at 46.7% of total imports (46.4% in the same period of 2018) and grew by 2.1% year-on-year.

Spain's trade surplus with the European Union and with the euro area increased to 15,425.4 million euros and to 10,177.9 million euros respectively, from surpluses of 13,823.2 million and 7,572.9 million euros in the same period of the previous year. The **trade deficit with the rest of the world** advanced by 3.8% year-on-year to 43,447.6 million euros.

In terms of **contribution to the annual change of exports** (up by 1.6%), the main contributions were those of the United States (0.3 percentage points), Switzerland (0.3 points), Portugal (0.3 points) and the United Kingdom (0.3 points). Those destinations with the largest negative contributions were Turkey (-0.2 points), Saudi Arabia (-0.2 points), Iran (-0.1 points) and Argentina (-0.1 points).

Imports (top/bottom contrib. to annual change, p.p.)




Exports (top/bottom contrib. to annual change, p.p.)

Regarding **imports**, the **countries with the largest contribution** to the annual change in Spain's **imports** in the period (up by 1.5%) were China (0.9 percentage points), the United States (0.8 points), the Netherlands (0.3 points) and Turkey (0.2 points). The destinations with the largest negative contributions were Iran (-0.7 points), France (-0.4 points), Brazil (-0.4 points) and Algeria (-0.3 points).

In the period January-October, the number of **Spanish exporters over 1.000 euros** attained 87,392, same value as in the same period of 2018, out of which 36,505 had already exported at least 50,000 euros worth of goods in the period, 1.3% more than in the same period of the previous year with an increase in exports of 1.6%. With regard to regular exporters (those that have already exported in the current year as well as in each of the three preceding years), they amounted to 51,999 in the period, 28.0% of total exporters and 2.2% more than in the same period of 2018. Their exports reached 231,117.6 million, 95.3% of total exports and 1.3% more than in the same period of the previous year.

International data

In comparison to other geographical areas, Spain's exports of goods expanded by 1.6% year-on-year in the period of January-October 2019, a lower rate than those attained by the euro area (2.2%) and the European Union (2.4%). Within the European Union, exports also increased in Germany (1.0%), France (3.7%) and Italy (2.7%), whereas those of the United Kingdom fell (-0.5%). Outside the European Union, the United States exports decreased by -1.4%, China's by -0.7% and Japan's by -5.3%.

METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

- The statistics presented in this report correspond to international trade in goods statistics of declared trade data provided by the Spanish <u>Customs and Excise Department</u> (Tax Agency) and compiled according to the UN Manual of International Merchandise Trade Statistics (IMTS 2010). It does not include Intra-EU estimates for trade below the exemption threshold.
- Data for the reference year are provisional. Final data are published at the end of the following year. In between, they are not subject to revision. In provisional data, those Intrastat operations being informed after the publication of its corresponding reference month will be assigned to the nearest pending month. Notwithstanding, in the final data all operations will be assigned to their corresponding reference month. Year-on-year percentage change is always calculated with homogenous data (provisional over provisional basis, even if final data are already available for the previous year).
- Information in real terms is provided by the Ministry of Economy and Business and it is calculated using Unit Value Indices.
- Data seasonally adjusted: the estimation of the model, the decomposition of the series and its seasonal and calendar adjustment have been carried out manually using TRAMO-SEATS program. The calendar regressors have been calculated taking into account INE's "Standard for adjusting seasonal and calendar effects in short-term series" (link). The selected models are: ARIMA (0,1,1) x (0,1,1) for exports and ARIMA (0,1,1) x (0,1,1) for imports, with the series in logarithms.
- Sectoral data: the correspondence table between sectors and sub-sectors shown in the report and the 5-digit codes of the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC Rev. 4) is available on:

- Geographic data: imports are classified according to the country of origin of the merchandise.
- All these data can be obtained from the foreign trade statistics website of the Secretariat of State for Trade, Datacomex (<u>http://datacomex.comercio.es/</u>), in the section corresponding to Spain. The user can make personalized queries according to different variables such as: flow, country, commodity or Spanish region.
- Spain's trade data presented in this report differ from those published by Eurostat in application of different methodologies: Spain's Customs (<u>link</u>, in Spanish) and Eurostat (<u>link</u>).
