




GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT AND COMPONENTS




**DOMESTIC DEMAND: COMPONENTS


HOUSING STARTS AND ACCRUED

y-o-y % change








CREDIT FOR HOUSE PURCHASE & MORTGAGES
