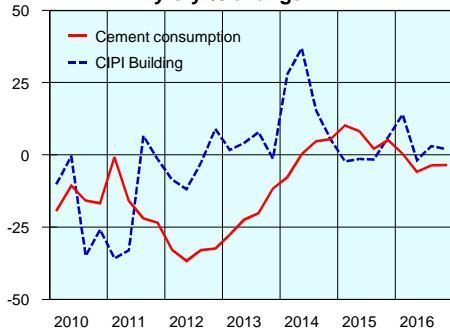

y-o-y % change



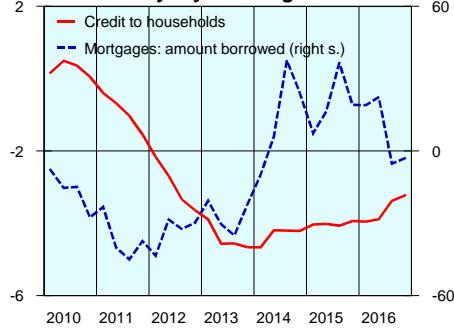

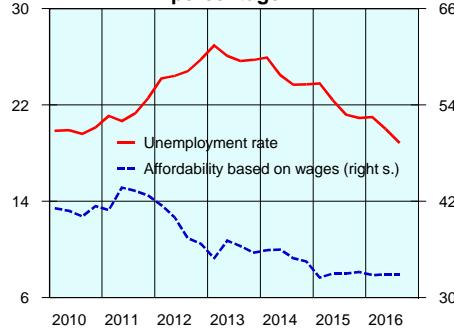
