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


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
NOVEMBER 2015

In November 2015 *Spain*'s exports increased by 8.6% year-on-year in nominal terms to 21,655.4 million euros, whereas imports augmented by 9.3% to 23,505.1 million euros. With seasonally adjusted data, exports grew by 6.7% year-on-year and imports by 7.2%. In real terms, exports grew by 8.5% year-on-year as export prices increased by 0.1%; meanwhile imports rose by 12.6% as import prices shrank by 2.9%. In nominal terms on a month-on-month basis, exports as well as imports declined by 2.3%. With seasonally adjusted data, exports and imports augmented by 1.0% and 1.4% month-on-month, respectively.






Spain's trade balance registered a deficit of 1,849.7 million euros, up from a 1,555.2 million euros deficit in November 2014 (provisional data). The export/import coverage ratio reached 92.1%, 0.7 percentage points lower than in the same month of 2014 (92.8% in November 2014 with provisional data). The non-energy trade balance reached a deficit of 41.9 million euros, in contrast to a surplus of 938.3 million in the same month of 2014. The energy trade deficit fell by 27.5% year-on-year to 1,807.7 million euros (against a deficit of 2,493.5 million euros in November 2014).




Sectoral data

Spain's main exporting sectors in November 2015 were capital goods (whose exports represented 20.7% of total and they advanced by 13.4% year-on-year); vehicles (19.0% of total, rising by 25.7%); food, beverages and tobacco (16.8% of total, growing by 11.6%) and chemical products (13.3% of total, increasing by 5.0%).



The **most significant sectors of** *Spain*'s **imports** were *capital goods* (whose imports represented 21.8% of total and augmented by 21.9% year-on-year); *chemical products* (15.2% of total imports, advancing by 13.0% over the previous year); *vehicles* (14.6% of total imports, increasing by 25.1%) and *energy* (11.9% of total imports, declining by 27.7%).


Among **subsectors**, **the largest contributions** to the annual change in *Spain*'s **exports** in November 2015 (up by 8.6%) came from *cars and motorcycles* (3.3 points), *automotive parts and accessories* (0.9 points) and *fruits*, *vegetables and legumes* (0.8 points). The major negative contributions corresponded to *oil and by-products* (-1.6 points), *iron and steel* (-0.6 points) and *railway transport equipment* (-0.6 points).




The **subsectors with the most positive contribution** to the annual change in *Spain*'s **imports** in November 2015 (9.3% increase) were *cars* and motorcycles (2.1 points), automotive parts and accessories (1.1 points) and other food products (1.0 points). The major negative contributions corresponded to *oil* and by-products (-4.2 points), gas (-0.8 points) and minerals (-0.7 points).

Geographic data

Exports to the *European Union* accounted for 66.3% of total exports in November 2015 (up from 64.7% in November 2014), and those to the *euro area* accounted for 51.3% (up from 51.1% in November 2014). Exports to the *European Union* grew by 11.3% year-on-year, while those to the *euro area* augmented by 8.9%. Exports to *non-EU countries* accounted for 33.7% of total exports in November 2015 (down from 35.3% in November 2014) and they increased by 3.7% year-on-year.




Imports from the *European Union* accounted for 58.7% of total imports in November 2015 (up from 56.8% in November 2014) and those from the *euro area* represented 46.7% (up from 44.5% in November 2014). Imports from the *European Union* grew by 13.0% year-on-year, while those from the *euro area* increased by 14.6%. Imports from *non-EU countries* accounted for 41.3% of total imports in November 2015 (down from 43.2% in November 2014) and they advanced by 4.5% year-on-year.



Trade balance with the *European Union* registered in November 2015 a surplus of 554.5 million euros (down from a surplus of 687.3 million in November 2014) and a surplus of 129.5 million euros with the *euro area* (down from 619.3 million surplus in November 2014). **Trade deficit with the** *rest of the world* increased to 2,404.2 million euros (from a deficit of 2,242.6 million euros in November 2014).

The **destinations with the largest contributions** to the annual change in *Spain*'s **exports** in November 2015 (up by 8.6%) were the *United Kingdom* (2.0 points), *Germany* (1.6 points), *Italy* (1.0 points) and *Morocco* (0.6 points). Those destinations with the largest negative contributions were *Ecuador* (-0.6 points), the *United States* (-0.3 points), *Taiwan* (-0.3 points) and *Brazil* (-0.2 points).



Regarding **imports**, the **countries with the largest contributions** to the annual change in *Spain*'s **imports** in November 2015 (up by 9.3%) were *Germany* (2.0 percentage points), *China* (1.8 points), *Italy* (1.6 points) and *France* (1.1 points). The destinations with the largest negative contributions were *Angola* (-1.1 points), *Mexico* (-0.9 points), *Algeria* (-0.7 points) and *Saudi Arabia* (-0.6 points).

International data

In comparison to other geographical areas, *Spain*'s exports of goods advanced by 8.6% year-on-year in November, a higher increase than that of the *euro area* (5.7%) and the *European Union* (5.2%), whereas within the *European Union*, exports also increased in *Germany* (7.7%), *France* (4.4%) and *Italy* (6.4%), whereas they decreased in the *United Kingdom* (-11.7%). Outside the *European Union*, *Japan*'s exports fell by 3.3% and those of the *United States* by 10.4%.


JANUARY – NOVEMBER 2015

Spain's exports in the period of January-November 2015 went up by 4.3% compared to the same period of 2014, reaching 230,085.8 million euros. **Imports advanced by 3.8%** year-on-year, totalling 252,465.8 million euros. In real terms, exports advanced by 3.6% year-on-year, as export prices rose by 0.7%, and imports increased by 6.1% year-on-year, as import prices diminished by 2.2%.

Spain's trade deficit decreased to 22,379.9 million euros down from a 22,650.1 million euros deficit in the same period of 2014. The export/import **coverage ratio** reached 91.1%, 0.4 percentage points higher than in the same period of 2014 (90.7%, provisional data). The **non-energy trade balance** recorded a surplus of 2,121.4 million euros, compared to a surplus of 12,899.0 million euros in January-November 2014, whereas the **energy trade deficit** declined by 31.1% year-on-year to 24,501.3 million euros.


Sectoral data

Spain's main exporting sectors in the period of January-November were *capital goods* (20.0% of total exports, increasing by 3.9% year-on-year); *vehicles* (17.1% of total, expanding by 19.7%); *food, beverages* and tobacco (16.0% of total, growing by 9.0%); and *chemical products* (14.4% of total, expanding by 6.1%).



The **largest shares by sector of** *Spain***'s imports** were *capital goods* (representing 20.1% of total imports, with imports surging by 18.7% year-on-year); *chemical products* (16.0% of total imports, advancing by 10.4%); *energy* (14.3% of total imports, shrinking by 30.1%); and *vehicles* (13.2% of total imports, increasing by 17.4%).


Among **subsectors**, the main contributors to the annual change to *Spain*'s **exports** (up by 4.3%) were cars and motorcycles (2.5 percentage points), fruits, vegetables and legumes (0.8 points) and garment (0.5 points). On the other side, the major negative contributions by subsectors corresponded to oil and byproducts (-1.4 points), gas (-0.7 points), and road transport equipment (-0.3 points).



The **subsectors with the largest contributions** to the annual change in *Spain*'s **imports** in January-November 2015 (up by 3.8%) were *cars and motorcycles* (1.4 points), *medicines* (0.8 points) and *electrical machinery* (0.7 points). The major negative contributions corresponded to *oil and by-products* (-5.5 points), *gas* (-1.0 points) and *minerals* (-0.1 points).

Geographic data

Exports to the *European Union* accounted for 65.0% of total exports in January-November 2015, up from 63.7% in the same period of 2014, while those to the *euro area* accounted for 50.6% of total (up from 50.1% in the same period of 2014). Exports to the *European Union* advanced by 6.4% year-on-year and those to the *euro area* by 5.4%. Exports to the *rest of the world* accounted for 35.0% of total exports (compared to 36.3% in the same period of 2014) and they increased by 0.5% year-on-year.




Imports from the *European Union* accounted for 55.8% of total imports in January-November 2015, up from 53.2% in the same period of 2014, while those from the *euro area* accounted for 44.5% (up from 42.8% in the same period of 2014). Imports from the *European Union* went up by 8.8% year-on-year and

those coming from the euro area by 7.9%. Imports from the rest of the world accounted for 44.2% of total imports (compared to 46.8% in the same period of 2014) and they fell by 2.0% year-on-year.

Spain's trade surplus with the European Union and with the euro area fell to 8,567.0 million euros and to 4,096.0 million euros respectively, down from surpluses of 10,996.5 million and 6,382.4 million euros in the same period of the previous year. The trade deficit with the rest of the world declined by 8.0% year-on-year to 30,946.9 million euros.

In terms of contribution to the annual change of exports (up by 4.3%), the main destinations for Spain's exports were Germany (which accounted for 0.9 percentage points), the United Kingdom (0.7 points), Italy (0.6 points) and France (0.5 points). On the contrary, the destinations with the largest negative contributions were Russia (-0.4 points), Taiwan (-0.2 points), Algeria (-0.2 points) and Brazil (-0.2 points).



0.2 Regarding imports, the countries with the largest contribution to the annual change in Spain's imports in November 2015 (up by 3.8%) were China (1.5 percentage points), Germany (1.5 points), the United States (0.9 points) and Italy (0.7 points). The destinations with the largest negative contributions were Russia (-1.2 points), Algeria (-1.0 points), Saudi Arabia (-0.7 points) and Nigeria (-0.6 points).

In January-November 2015, the number of Spanish exporters fell by 0.4% year-on-year to 140,001 exporters, out of which 37,462 had already exported at least 50,000 euros worth of goods in the period, dropping by 1.3% year-on-year. With regard to regular exporters (those that have already exported in the current year as well as in each of the three preceding years), they amounted to 47,379 in the period, 4.2% more than in the same period of the previous year.



In comparison to other geographical areas, Spain's exports of goods went up by 4.3% year-on-year in the period of January-November 2015, the same rate than that those of the euro area, but lower than that of the European Union (4.8%). Exports also increased in Germany (6.7%), France (4.0%) and Italy (3.8%), whereas those of the United Kingdom fell (-2.6%). Outside the European Union, Japan's exports increased by 4.7%, whereas those of the *United States* decreased by 6.8%.
